- 1. Jaime Gilliland from the Community Engagement Institute at WSU talked about a project they are doing in the Center for Applied Research and Evaluation. They are doing a community needs assessment for Sedgwick and Crawford counties. They want to interview people who have knowledge and a broad overview of the LGBTQ community, especially transgender people, in those counties. They are hoping to do 40-50 interviews in September or October.
- 2. Stephanie Kreutzer has some fliers and cards she can drop off for future events where the coalition needs literature to distribute.
- 3. Lisa Kilmer talked about attending the National HIV Testing Day event at M-Care Clinic. She helped staff the Free Mom Hugs booth.
- 4. Nolin Talked about The Center of Wichita having a table at City Wide Pride on June 24. He also said he would look at what materials might be available to print and distribute.
- 5. Dawna also attended City Wide Pride and the event at M-Care.
- 6. Jim Hall gave an update on what's in the works for Wichita Pride. The event will be at Century 2 on September 25-26. There will be food trucks, a Saturday night entertainment show, and other events which will take place in the convention hall and exhibition hall. The opening show will be at 8 pm on Saturday. The parade will be on Sunday. Table of Hope will not be allowed to sell food indoors but will set up outside for their fundraiser. Wichita Pride hopes to get some new sponsors and vendors. They will update their site soon. Volunteers are needed. There's been a call for artists to submit works that go with this year's theme, "Rainbow Resilience." The deadline to submit art is July 20. There is still some concern about the Delta variant of COVID-19 having an impact on Pride events. The board will watch the trends.
- 7. Amanda Mogoi, WASAC, and the Safe Place program at Wichita Children's Home expressed interest in having booths at Pride. Their contact info was passed on to Jim Hall.
- 8. Nolin asked if the coalition and the Center of Wichita would have separate tables for Pride. He also wondered what we might have to hand out; are we doing first aid kits again? Previously some were donated by Walgreens. Nolin reports that the coalition has \$394.80 in the account. Amanda Mogoi said she will ask Andy at Community Walgreens about donating first aid kits again.
- 9. Jessica Huber has a tool kit for older LGBT adults and their supporters. She works for CPAAA. She is also an ambassador for the National Resource Center on LGBT Aging.
 10. Dawna highlighted several Pride events around the state, including recent events in Lawrence, Manhattan, and Salina. Deerfield, KS in the southwestern part of the state will have an event on July 10. Nolin expressed an interest in attending on behalf of the coalition. Dawna sent him contact information for the organizer.
- 11. Amanda gave an update about the National HIV Testing Day event held at her clinic, M-Care Healthcare. In previous years, Community Walgreens never had more than 25 people show up for testing. This year, 60 people were tested. Positive Directions and Community Walgreens also co-hosted this event. Providers were also able to start 4 or 5 people on PrEP. The event ended with a drag show. The Emerald City Sisters were also in attendance.
- 12. Paige Bailey reports that she will be leaving Wichita Children's Home next week to work at Big Brothers Big Sisters. She plans to still attend coalition meetings.
- 13. Jenny Pierce will be leaving WASAC as well. She hopes that her new position allows her to attend coalition meetings in the future.
- 14. Dawna talked about her new position at HealthCore Clinic as the program coordinator for the OneCare Kansas.
- 15. Jim Hall talked about a board opening on Wichita Pride for a parade director. The big job for this person is to get people into their correct spaces in the parade lineup. There is always room for more Pride volunteers. Board meetings are open to the public, and feedback is welcome.

August 2021 Wichita LGBT Health Coalition Meeting Minutes

- The meeting opened with an update on Wichita Pride regarding exhibitor booths and parade entries. The deadline was August 20th but has been extended to the end of August. There are still some spots available.
- Randolyn Haley from Unite Us presented information about the new platform being built out in the Wichita area. Unite Us (and Unite Kansas) addresses the social determinants of health through agency and provider networks for those seeking services. The platform will launch September 14, 2021 in 5 area counties, including Sedgwick, Butler, Harvey, and Reno. It's already live in the KC area and 44 other states. It is a free referral network able to connect people to services in a trauma-informed way. It is free to community-based organizations. There is no cost for provider's to be listed. Sarah Vaughn, Aaron Walker, and Nolin Christensen were interested in receiving more information from Ms. Haley.
- Aaron Walker pointed out that a similar pilot program has been in use for about the last two years in the Sedgwick County Health Department: IRIS. However, IRIS has an annual cost for use. It has 40-50 participating agencies and providers.
- Ms. Haley was familiar with IRIS. She reported that Unite Us has a stronger feedback loop and no cost.
 It also provides data on co-occurring needs. Useful reports can be generated as well from the data.
 Information sessions for Unite Us are going on now and scheduled for the next few weeks. Check their website for dates and times.
- Stephanie Kreutzer said that she and Lisa Kilmer, who both update the directory listings, will soon be adding telehealth resources. Provider Michael Baker will be offering telehealth services.
- Nolin reminded us about the upcoming NDO discussions. There is lots of noise from the religious right at the listening tour meetings and DAB meetings where public comment is allowed. We need to all be adding our voices to the discussions. It would be especially helpful if affirming churches would become involved as well.
- Kim Neufeld shared that Bike Walk Wichita is hiring a part-time person from the LGBTQ community to lead walks and keep people active. It has great potential to be a safe, affirming space with healthy activities and networking opportunities. This grant-funded position is for one year and requires someone to work a few hours a week. Those interested in applying should be outgoing, comfortable on social media, and able to share about community resources. Kim will send a job description that can be distributed to the coalition mailing list.
- Stephanie mentioned upcoming conferences by SYNC2020 and GLMA. She will also be posting about directory providers during the weeks leading up to Wichita Pride 2021. Those interested in being featured should contact Stephanie with their information.
- Judi Brown updated us on happenings at Cigna Insurance. They are currently adding a section to their provider directory that allows providers to self-identify as LGBTQ-friendly. Interested providers can go to the Cigna credentialing site to sign up. Some other insurance carriers also utilize the same site. Cigna also has an employee support group for the LGBTQ community and their allies. There's also a telehealth expansion initiative. Facebook and Google will help build out transgender and nonbinary health benefits in Asia, thus expanding health equity.
- Aaron Walker, Executive Director of Cairn Health, let us know that his organization is doing an all-

remote model and will likely stick with that going forward. Cairn Health offers prescription and vision services. They are moving their offices to North Broadway. He is also part of the Health Alliance of Sedgwick County, another coalition that meets.

- Steve Burt is the CEO of Bel Aire Recovery. He and his husband are new to Wichita as of October 1, 2020. Bel Aire Recovery is a residential treatment facility. They serve LGBTQ clients. They are a forprofit facility. Steve wants to network with other providers. His email is sburt@belairerecovery.com.
- Denise Vann from the Alzheimers Association asked about filling out the provider directory application. Their association is LGBTQ-friendly. Most people at the association are currently working remotely. Stephanie will email Denise with more information about the application.

- Ellen Bertels, a first-year lawyer, presented to the group about her grant that will help LGBTQ+ individuals with legal services, including name changes and gender marker changes. Ellen helped with the name/gender marker change clinic while a law student at KU. She now works for Kansas Legal Services. She can help people even if they do not meet low-income guidelines. There's a possibility that she may be able to help with legal challenges resulting from the NDO as well, but she's not sure. It will depend on the role of Kansas Legal Services in processing the challenges for the City of Wichita. Ellen can be reached at bertelse@klsinc.org
- Kansas Legal Services will also be offering a driver's license clinic for those who have a suspended license and resulting fees. There is an amnesty program to help those who have low incomes and can't afford the associated fees.
- Amanda Mogoi from M-Care Healthcare highlighted the adult and teen transgender support groups that are now meeting. M-Care is also partnering with Positive Directions and Community Walgreens to provide PrEP.
- Jeff McGaffin from Sedgwick County Health Department shared that the county will be doing free HIV and syphilis testing on December 1 as part of World AIDS Day. He also suggested that the Wichita LGBT Health Coalition should add more information about syphilis to its STI page, since syphilis is on the rise.
